Teams:

- 10 team squads of 3 players (see over/below). **You need to be sure which team you are in and what number player you are.**
- Each team is either in the 1.00 (Team 1s) or 3.00 (Team 3s) League
- No designated skips – agree in your pair or toss a coin!
- 4 games for each squad member
- Pair for each date is pre-arranged (see below)

<u>Date</u>	<u>Players</u>
3 July	1 and 2
10 July	1 and 3
17 July	2 and 3
24 July	1 and 3
31 July	2 and 3
7 August (Final / Play off)	1 and 2

Please check the four dates you are playing. If you have to change, please do it in your team, but make sure everyone plays 4 games. To do anything different is outside the spirit of this competition!

Format:

- normal pairs
 - 12 ends / 3 woods
 - all current COVID playing restrictions to be followed
- First 5 weeks are a **league basis**. Each team plays all the others, with 2 points for a win, 1 for a draw or abandoned match. No bonus points. Points difference will be used to place teams with equal points.

Each week there is one “**friendly**” between the two teams without a league match.

All teams will play.

Players 1 and 2 from each team will play.

Top team in each league will play the final; 2nd team in each league play for 3rd and 4th place, etc, etc to the two bottom teams play for 9th and 10th place.
